

How Georgia State University Emeriti Faculty Can Secure Free Parking at the GSU Downtown Campus

First, register no more than two vehicles at Parking and Transportation (<https://parking.gsu.edu>) by

- locating the blue box, in the upper right- hand corner, labeled” New Parking System”, followed by
- clicking “Register Vehicle,” after which you will be taken to a log in box for
- typing in your campus ID and password and clicking “log in” which will allow you to provide necessary vehicle information for registration.

You can download and print/save a parking map for the downtown GSU campus parking lots/decks at <https://map.concept3d.com/?id=1108#!ce/27051?ct/0,29782?s/faculty/staff%20parking> Remember, Emeriti have free parking but do not have reserved designated spaces. At certain times of the day, particular lots may be full.

Second, check your current Panther Card. If it does not designate you as Emeriti Faculty, you will need to secure a new Panther Card in the downtown campus Book Store Building, Suite 200. Be sure to have your current Panther card with you and a government photo id to identify you. The Panther card and vehicle license plate is your parking credential to access GSU downtown campus parking decks and lots. To enter a lot or deck on campus, you will need to swipe your Panther card that designates you as an Emeriti. Be sure to carry your Panther card with you at all times.

Once you have secured your Panther card designating you as Emeriti Faculty and you have registered no more than two vehicles , you are qualified to park free in any GSU downtown campus lots/decks.
